Over the 20 months I've been active in this group the question of copyright infringement has surfaced more than once.

As you probably well know from your monitoring, this group does not routinely handle Color Climax material in original form. Very occasionally an outsider will post some (Tove fans are irrepressible), but will then likely be in receipt of a message from a group "policeman" saying "uh-uh".

Information that CCC-derived but HR-constructed items were in the public domain, once posted, was given to us; an account of Dutch copyright law permitting use of (I think) 75% of a copyrighted item was given to us; over quite a period of time it was implied that HR and CCC were in some sort of amicable relationship that made it all OK.

Just possibly we have been sold down the river.

You put forward the claim that we have been sinners all along -- and I must say (without even having read the multitude of references you provided) that common sense would seem to bear that out.

In any event, I have no desire to test the validity of your position. In the words of The Gambler "Ya gotta know when to hold, ya gotta know when to fold", and I, for one, am folding.
